After several years of use and virtually no maintenance, many owners' only expense has been replacement blades. With the windrow spreader attachment, you get a simple inexpensive built-in-tedder. Many owners report the hay dries down quicker or the same as conditioned hay. With tedder/spreader removed, you can windrow the hay to save a raking trip. The Reese drum mower has an adjustable gauge wheel which allows you to easily adjust the height when topping pasture which many graziers report, gives quicker regrowth than rotary mowed grass. No other machine on the market has the time and money saving features that the Reese drum mower has. Because of the simplicity, fast dry down, and no fear of breakdowns, the Reese mower is the best investment you can make when purchasing your next hay mower. 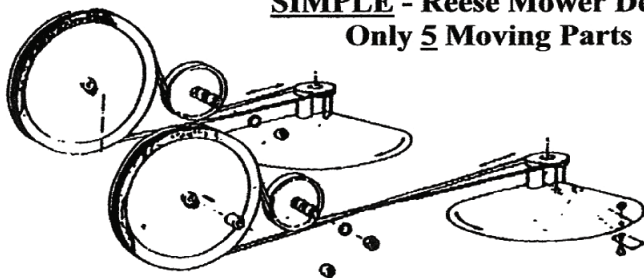
